AMETI Eastern Busway

Streetlight and services installation outside Pakuranga Plaza Day and Night Works

Dear Residents.

This work is related to the construction of Stage 1 of the AMETI Eastern Busway between Panmure and Pakuranga.

What's happening?

Day works:

From **Monday 28 June to Monday 12 July,** during the day, we will be installing stormwater, streetlights and services in the berm on Pakuranga Road east of Ti Rakau Drive, and on Ti Rakau Drive near the Pakuranga Road intersection (see **page 2** for the approximate worksite).

The ring road in Pakuranga Plaza carpark and some rows of parks closest to the worksite will be closed for the full duration of these works. Pedestrian detours will be in place.

To accommodate the machinery required to carry out these works, the slip lane from Pakuranga Road onto Ti Rakau Drive will be closed between **10am and 2pm**. You can still turn left from Pakuranga Road into Ti Rakau Drive from the westbound lanes at the intersection.

Night works:

Between **Monday 5 July to Friday 9 July**, we will be installing lighting and services **at night** on Pakuranga Road east of Ti Rakau Drive and on Ti Rakau Drive near the Pakuranga Road intersection (see **page 2** for the approximate worksite).

Pakuranga Road and Ti Rakau Drive will both remain open. Pakuranga Road will be reduced to one single westbound lane. You will be able to turn left onto Ti Rakau Drive at the intersection. Alternate exits from Pakuranga Plaza carpark to Pakuranga Road and Ti Rakau Drive will be in place with traffic management on-site to assist.

How will you be affected?

Work hours – 7.30am to 6.00pm during the day, and from 9.00pm to 5.00am at night. The crew will arrive/set up and pack up/depart outside of these hours.

Vehicle access – Pakuranga Road and Ti Rakau Drive will remain open throughout this work with traffic management in place. Between 10.00am and 2.00pm, the Pakuranga Road to Ti Rakau Drive intersection slip lane will be closed. You can use the westbound lanes at the intersection to turn left onto Ti Rakau Drive. The Pakuranga Plaza ring road will be closed for the duration of these works to accommodate the work area.

Pedestrians and cyclists - access will be maintained at all times with traffic management in place.

Noise and vibration - Noise and vibration associated with this night work will be within the limits set as part of the approved site-specific plan. The majority of this work will not be particularly noisy, including attaching traffic signal lanterns, pulling cables, testing software and working in cabinets.



Thin, shallow trenches do need to be cut to install the remaining traffic loops, and as much as possible, the road surface will be saw cut during the daytime. During night works, we will be using a hydro excavator at the start of the shift. All construction work areas will be cordoned off. Please discuss this work with friends and family, in particular children, to ensure they aren't entering the site.
